

The Narrow Path

This is an Elementary Level story in a series of ELT readers comprising a wide range of titles - some original and some simplified - from modern and classic novels, and designed to appeal to all age-groups, tastes and cultures. The books are divided into five levels: Starter Level, with about 300 basic words; Beginner Level (600 basic words); Elementary Level (1100); Intermediate Level (1600); and Upper Level (2200). Some of the titles are also available on cassette. In a time when competing and often irreconcilable belief systems seem to dominate all religious conversation in Christianity, N. Graham Standish offers an alternative for leading a spiritual and faithful life. Providing models that embrace elements of many spiritual traditions within Christianity, *Discovering the Narrow Path* seeks to hold all extremist positions in perfect tension, by integrating their essential truths yet also recognizing their flaws. In doing so, Standish surveys the wisdom of the mystics, the practice of forming a Trinitarian faith, the openness of healing traditions, and the value of balancing prayer and action, as well as spirituality, theology, and religion. Complete with two appendices, one a guide for group study and one an introduction to spiritual reading, *Discovering the Narrow Path* is an essential resource for those seeking spiritual fulfillment.

Jesus said in the book of Matthew that the path to destruction is wide and many people follow it. But the narrow path, though difficult, leads to eternal life and there are few that will find it. This material captures areas of vital importance for every Christian, including pursuing eternity, building your eternal legacy, acknowledging and overcoming sin, and receiving God's blessings and favors. Also included is a unique method of praying, called the 7 Prayer Steps, that may forever change the way you communicate with God. Aggravators sometimes look like they are pursuing good things, but their heart is not toward reconciliation. Any motive less than reconciliation falls short of the desires of God's heart. We need godly advocates in every sphere of life. This book will specifically apply these principles to issues of ethnic division. Are you willing to call any division caused by discrimination, prejudice, or racism a sin? Do you want to grow in your ability to navigate tense and emotional conversations about ethnic divisions? The Narrow Path is about forgiveness. It is easy to say that you forgive someone, but since it is almost impossible to forget when you are offended, "true" forgiveness is extremely difficult to release. Scripture says you should forgive someone who wronged you seventy times seven times. Jesus is not saying to forgive 490 times; he's talking about forgiving in the most extreme situations—for example, the 430 years of the Israelites' captivity in Egypt. The Narrow Path explores a situation when two men meet along a path (one is a murderer, the other the victim) in a place where time has no meaning. Jesus forgave even the people who crucified him (Luke 23:34), but we sometimes cannot forgive even the slightest wrong against us. We must remember that the path to heaven is very narrow, so if you have an unforgiving and bitter heart, you cannot receive the kingdom of heaven. Can you love your enemy enough to forgive him? Overcoming an unforgiving heart cannot be done without the Holy Spirit because he provides the fruit: love, peace, joy, patience, gentleness, goodness, faithfulness, kindness, and self-control. The Narrow Path tells the story of a case of forgiving a difficult wrong and repenting and how God forgives us as well.

Still mourning the sudden loss of her husband, a tearful Rebecca boards a plane to Rome. As gut-wrenching as it is to travel alone, she is determined to have the dream vacation she and her husband planned before his death. She doesn't expect to meet a sexy widower from New York. Harrison Sterling was born with a silver spoon and a trust fund and has never known love that wasn't dependent upon his last name and material things. When Rebecca voices her aversion to people of wealth, he hides his background. But he can't hide his attraction to the widow from Philadelphia. However, when we search with a deep desire to know what He actually did and taught, we find a big discrepancy between that and what is most often taught. All Christians owe it to themselves and to their Savior to make sure they are living as He desires them to live and not merely following the doctrines and traditions they have come to accept as fact. This book will challenge and encourage you to go further with God. It will help you re-evaluate many areas of your life according to the timeless truths of Scripture taken at face value. The sad truth is that many Christians are totally unaware of the fact that they have been deceived. Thus, they are not living the lives God desires them to live. This book is a journey in finding out what the disciples of Jesus knew and

how this affected their lives. You will be surprised to see how different the lives of those believers were from the lives of believers today. When you are finished, you will be able to answer the question: "Are you really on the narrow path or have you been deceived?"

Where will you spend eternity? How do you become a Christian? How do you live as a Christian? Find answers to these questions as you hike down the narrow path with Linda. Wide is the road that leads to destruction, but narrow is the path that leads to eternal life. This book serves as a complete guide to the Christian faith.
